1. Challenge Statement

2. Background Narrative

An NFT is a digital asset that represents real-world objects like art, music, in-game items and videos. They are bought and sold online, frequently with cryptocurrency, and they are generally encoded with the same underlying software as many cryptos.

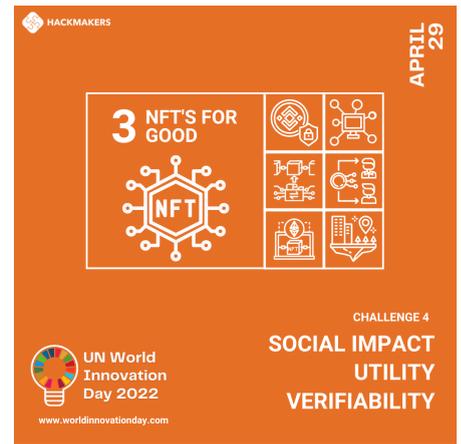
The emergence of NFTs and decentralized communities has also led to a new way of thinking about social responsibility and sustainability. For example, many projects in the NFT space are developing road maps that outline how they plan to use their NFTs to create social value and improve the world around them.

More than ever, we need to take advantage of and harness the potential of these new technologies to ensure that we are better equipped and more united in the future, in order to make our planet a more livable, equitable place for all.

It is important that your solution contains:

- An art piece, graphic or visualisation of what the NFT sample may look like.
- A clear pitch deck, that includes the following components:
 - The problem under the SDG that the NFT is solving (e.g. carbon emissions)
 - The target market and their relevance to own the NFT
 - The target audience who are the beneficiaries of the NFT's function/ utility
 - An explanation of its utility, and how its function and performance can be properly verified
 - A comparative analysis with other NFT's already in the market in a similar area
 - A strategy to how the NFT will be marketed, what channels you plan to use to bring awareness
